Arizona expanded the ESA program to every Arizona family—in partnership with the Payment Manager, ClassWallet, the Arizona Department of Education administers the program and both will help you apply, manage your funds, make payments, answer your questions, and create a custom education!

- ✓ **To use your ESA with Veritas Press,** first log into your ClassWallet account: esaportal.azed.gov
- ✓ **Direct Pay** — With your receipt or invoice in hand, find Veritas Press on ClassWallet using the “Pay” tab on your ClassWallet homepage. When approved, ClassWallet will send Veritas Press a payment.
- ✓ **ClassWallet Marketplace** — Find Veritas Press and make your purchase online with the “Start Shopping” tab on your ClassWallet homepage. These payments will take you right to checkout.
