QUICK FACTS

Name: Educational Freedom Accounts

Eligibility: Previous students, first-time kindergartners, students in "D" or "F" schools, students with disabilities, foster students, and students in military, first responder, veteran, and law enforcement families.

Maximum Amount: Up to \$6,856

Qualifying educational expenses: Private School Tuition, Online Education, Textbooks, Curricula, Computers, Technology, and more!
