

# Texas EFA Quick Start Guide

The Texas Education Freedom Account (EFA) program is a flexible, state-funded scholarship program that helps K-12 students access customized educational opportunities. The program allows families to use scholarship funds on approved education expenses and online private school tuition to create a learning experience that best fits their child's needs.

## QUICK FACTS

**Name:** Texas Education Freedom Accounts

**Eligibility:** Eligible students are U.S citizens or lawfully present in the United States are eligible to attend a Texas school district or open-enrollment charter school or pre-K program.

**Applications:** Applications are closed until the 2027-2028 school year window opens.

**Amount:** \$10,000 for the private school tuition pathway, \$2,000 for the unbundled/at home pathway.

**Qualifying Educational Expenses:** Private School Tuition, Online Education, Textbooks, Curriculum, and more!

### ✓ To Use Your ESA with Veritas Press:

first log into your Odyssey account: *withodyssey.com*

✓ **Marketplace:** funds are deposited into the account, you can select Veritas Press directly through the platform.

✓ **Reimbursement:** you would purchase the Veritas Press curriculum or course with personal funds, then submit a reimbursement request in the portal. You'll need to upload your receipt and purchase details.
