Live Online Courses

Veritas Scholars Academy offers live online classes for both students accepted into the Diploma Program and students who choose the “à la carte” option. Take one class or a full load—it’s up to you! Your students can take part in our selection of world-class offerings in whatever way fits into your student’s unique educational program. Full-time Diploma and part-time students take the same classes together.

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Course Schedule

During the school year, students enrolled in VSA Live courses meet twice a week (M/W or T/TH) in real time for an interactive learning experience with teachers and peers. We have no more than 20 students per class. Our average class size is 17, enabling our teachers to know their students and their learning needs well.
