Jesus is buried in a tomb. A stone is rolled over the entrance to the tomb and Roman soldiers stand guard.

Mary Magdalene visits Jesus' tomb with some friends. When they get there, the stone is rolled away and the tomb is empty.

Two men dressed in white robes appear and tell them that Jesus has risen from the dead.

9

Mary goes to tell the disciples that Jesus has risen from the dead. They do not believe her until Jesus appears to them.

10

Jesus returns to His Father in heaven.
