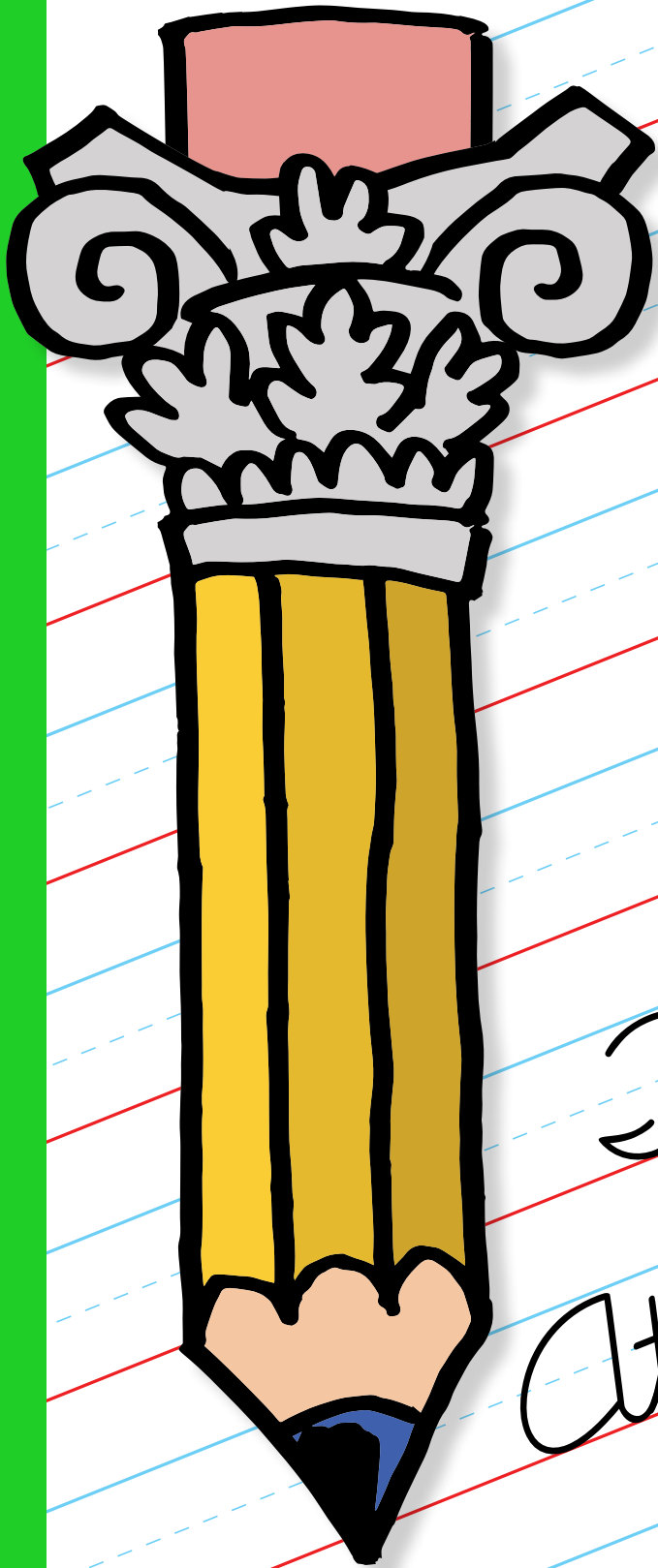

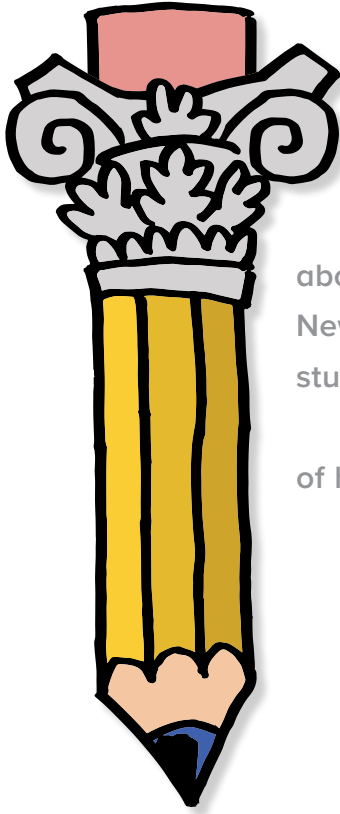

One of the things we learn about Him in the Bible is that He is there. He does exist.

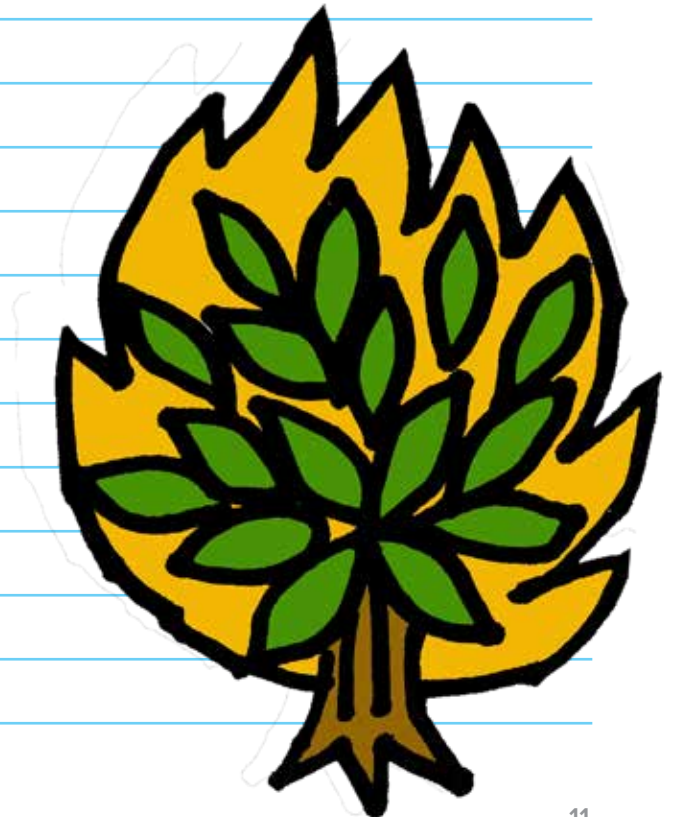
