This book is intended as a learning-aid to students studying Latin from the **Latin For Children: Primer C** textbook. It follows that textbook chapter for chapter. Thus, the vocabulary words learned on chapter five of the textbook correlate to those in chapter five of this activity book.

Not all puzzles will appeal to all students. Feel free to have students jump around or even skip puzzles.
