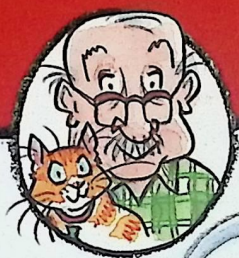

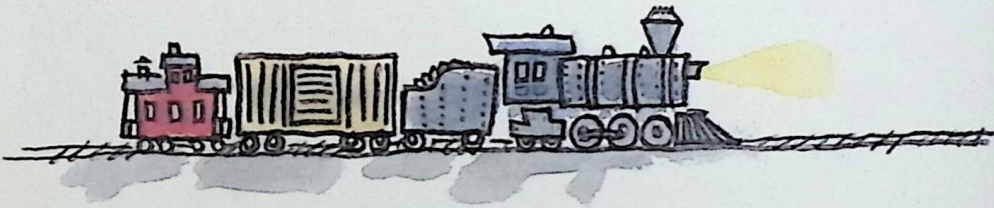
Toys

they always stopped at the toy store.





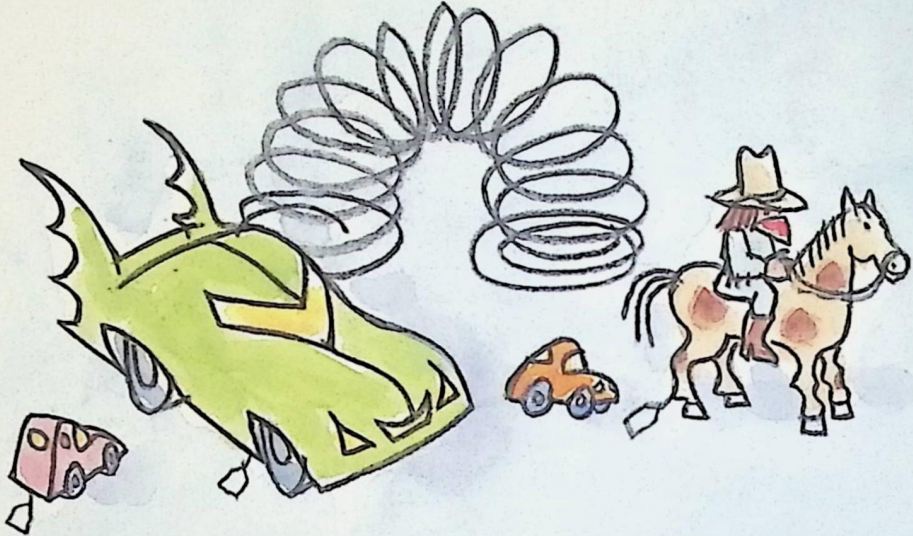
Tabby was not happy at the toy store.
